

# REFRESH YOUR AIR WITH EASY CARE HOUSEPLANTS

**Here are our top indoor plant choices for beginners and experts alike who want no fail plant options. While you enjoy these plants that are nearly impossible to kill, purify your home's air and reduce your stress.**

**PHILODENDRONS:** Many varieties exist and come in different shapes and forms including split leaf, upright and trailing. All types need low to medium light. Let the soil dry between watering's.

**POTHOS:** Needs low to medium light– the more light it receives, the better color variation of leaves. Keep the soil moderately dry. Great for hanging or putting in a high spot as it trails and cascades.

**FERNS:** Needs medium to bright light. Keep the soil evenly moist. Loves humidity. Minimal care needed. Needs may change based on fern variety.

**PEACE LILY:** Low light lover; whose soil surface should be dry between watering's. Great for bathrooms. Consistently blooms white flowers.

**JADE PLANT:** Medium to bright light needed. Tolerates neglect well. Soil surface should be dry between watering's. Loves to be root bound.

**SNAKE PLANT:** Low to bright light loving. Tolerates neglect well. Soil surface should be dry between watering's.

**FIDDLE LEAF FIG & FICUS TREES:** Needs medium to bright light. Water when the soil surface is dry. Periodically dust off the plant leaves.

**ALOE:** Medium to bright light loving. Easy to care for. Plant should be dry in between watering's. Known for healing properties.

**IVY:** Medium to bright light loving. Keep the soil evenly moist. Occasionally rinse leaves to prevent mites. Great for individuals with allergies and asthma.

**SUCCULENTS AND CACTI:** Bright light loving. Tolerates neglect well. Water well when the plant is completely dry.
